IMPLEMENTATION OF 2012 TUITION FEE FREE EDUCATION AND TUITION FEE SUBSIDY POLICY

The National Government Policy on Tuition Fee Free and Subsidized Education are in two components.

The first component covers all students attending Elementary Prep to Grade 10 in registered and approved schools in the National Education System who will have tuition fee free education this year. This means that the Government will pay all tuition fees for all children who enroll in school when school starts on February 6th.

The second component of the policy will be subsidized education for all students attending Grades 11 and 12, Vocational Centres, Flexible, Open and Distance Education (FODE) Centres and approved Permitted Schools.

The Government will pay 75 % of their fees while their parents will pay 25%.

The National Government has appropriated K300 million in the Supplementary Budget in 2011 and another K302 million in the Recurrent Budget for the Department of Education 2012 Budget, making it a total of K602 million to implement the Tuition Fee Free Education and Subsidy Policy.

The K300 million will be used for the first payment. This funding will relieve the financial burden on parents and guardians of students having to pay tuition fees in 2012.

The National Government is taking increasingly more of the financial burden from parents in 2012 but this does not mean that parents do not have any responsibility for the education of their children.

Parents are still required to pay for other, non tuition costs of education such as school uniforms, transport and lunches. Parents will also be expected to support schools in the funding of projects that have been approved by respective Provincial Education Boards.

In cases where parents have paid more than the approved parental component school authorities must refund the difference.

NATIONAL EDUCATION BOARD (NEB) 2012 MAXIMUM TUITION FEE LIMITS AND NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CONTRIBUTION AND PARENTAL CONTRIBUTION

Payment for students under the Subsidized and Tuition Fee Free funds will be based on the NEB Maximum Fee Limits approved by the NEB in 2011 for the 2012 academic year.

The Table below shows the National Education Board (NEB) Maximum Tuition Fee Limits for 2012 for the different sectors in Column 2, the National Government Contribution in Column 3 and the Parental Contribution in Column 4.

The figures shown in column 3 above for Approved Permitted Schools and Inclusive Education Resource Centres were set by the Department of Education.

2012 TUITION FEE FREE AND TUITION FEE SUBSIDY PAYMENTS

The 2012 Tuition Fee Free and Tuition Fee Subsidy funds will be paid to schools in two (2) installments.

The first installment will be paid in January 2012. The first lot of payments for Tuition Fee Free will be the first 50% of the Tuition Fee Free component set by the National Education Board (NEB) for Elementary Schools (EP, E1, E2), Primary Schools (Grades 3-8) and Lower Secondary Schools (Grade 9 and Grade 10). The payments are based on the 2011 enrolment figures provided by schools to the Department of Education through the National Education Schools Census Forms (NESCF).

The first lot of payments for Tuition Fee Subsidy will be 67% of the Tuition Fees set by NEB for Upper Secondary Schools and National High Schools (Grade 11 and Grade 12), and Vocational Centres. The payments are based on the 2011 enrolment figures provided by schools to the Department of Education through the NESCF.

The first installment will also include a one off payment of K75 which is the fee limit set by the National Education Board while K83 that will be paid, is the fee calculated from the 10% inflation rate per student for the Flexible, Open and Distance Education (FODE) Institutions. Similarly K30 is the fee limit set by the NEB while K33 that will be paid is derived from the 10% inflation rate for the Inclusive Education Resource Centres and the approved Permitted Schools. The second installment of Tuition Fee Free and Tuition Fee Subsidy payments will be paid in June/July 2012.

The second lot of payments for Tuition Fee Free will be the second 50% of the Tuition Fees Limit set by the National Education Board (NEB) for Elementary Schools (EP, E1, E2), Primary Schools (Grades 3-8) and Vocational Centres. The second lot of payments will be based on the 2012 enrolment figures from the NESCF provided by schools.

The second lot of payments for Tuition Fee Subsidy will be 33% of the Tuition Fees Limit set by NEB for Upper Secondary Schools and National High Schools (Grade 11 and Grade 12). The second lot of payments will be based on the 2012 enrolment figures from the NESCF provided by schools.

Therefore, all schools are required to return/submit their 2012 National Education Schools Census Forms (NESCF) to the Research and Data Analysis Branch of the Department of Education, by the 30th of April 2012.

Where a school fails to submit its NESCF with its 2012 enrolment figures to the Department of Education before the end of April 2012, the Department will use the schools 2011 enrolment figures for the second payment of the Tuition Fee Free and Tuition Fee Subsidy in 2012.

SCHOOLS THAT HAVE NIL DATA RECORDS

There are schools that have failed to submit their NESCF to the Department of Education, resulting in nil data recorded against the schools. These Nil Data schools will not receive any funds from the Tuition Fee Free and Tuition Fee Subsidy in the first installment payments which will be paid in January 2012.

Schools in this category need to submit the data to the Department as soon as possible.

METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION

The Manual Cheque Payment Method, which has been the normal practice in the past, is costly and open to abuse. Therefore under the new management, schools without bank accounts are now being strongly encouraged to immediately open bank accounts with the commercial banks of their choice, preferably BSP for electronic transfer of funds and submit the account details to the contact details provided.

The method adopted to transfer funds electronically is aimed at ensuring that the Tuition Fee Free and Tuition Fee Subsidy funds to schools are delivered in a timely manner.

All future payments under this policy will be paid through the banking system electronically. This method requires the funds to be transferred directly into school bank accounts.

BANK ACCOUNT DETAILS

School Boards, Head Teachers, Provincial Education Advisors and Community Leaders must ensure their schools have current operating bank accounts. The details of the bank accounts are to be communicated to the Department of Education through the contact details given. School Boards and Head Teachers are strongly advised to facilitate schools to open a bank account immediately. After verification of the bank account by the Department of Education, the Bank South Pacific will begin transferring the funds electronically to the respective bank accounts.

Those schools that do not have bank accounts:

- 1. Allow the students to be enrolled
- 2. Go to the nearest BSP Branch and open a School Account immediately.

Department of Education officers will not be distributing the cheques to the provinces as has been the practice in the past. The breakdown of monies to be paid to provinces under different sectors are summarised in the tables below:
